More than hundred new children joined with the session. An entrance test was held for the children who went to other schools prior their joining here for the inclusion in different classes.

Felicitation day (March 9): The felicitation day marked the presence of our friend Mrs. Chemi la from German Aid to Tibetans, Germany. All the children having the general proficiency grading received prize from our special guest friend.

Meditation practice (March 15): A visit by Mr. Vivek PalTo inculcate the proper way of meditation.

Calligraphy winners (March 24): A moment of proud when the school principal announced the names of 18 students of our school who received prize for their excellence in Tibetan essay writing and calligraphy. The contest was an inter school competition as organized for all the Tibetan schools by Department of Education, Central Tibetan Administration, Dharamsala.

Leadership Training (April 4): To develop a good leadership quality in our children. A group of children studying in higher secondary of our school participates in annual leadership workshop as organized by Department of Education at Dharsamsala.

Creative writing tips (April 11): Activist Mr. Tenzin Tsudue visited our school to assist our senior students with his guidelines and the tips to write creative English.







Founder's Day (April 23): A celebration of the successful journey of 56 years commenced with a scarf ceremony showing our gratitude to His Holiness the Dalai Lama and also to all the ones connected with our family of THF to assist us to provide the best to children under our care. Her highness Sakya Dagmo Kalden la makes the day more auspicious with her presence as Chief Guest. A prize ceremony makes the day memorable with a citation to our six staff who served for the last 20 years and certificate to best students of the year including environment club members.

Annual Spring Fete (April 24): The most awaited day for our children comes a day after the founder's day. Different stalls with varieties of snacks, games and shopping can be seen on the school basket court on the day. Special delicacies of the day were the Indian spices and fresh momo's attracting everyone to their counter. The day was observed as a fundraising day where all the staff tries with their best participation.

Class – X graduation (April 16th): An emotional day when our children living in Rajpur branch school leaves to join THF Mussoorie for the senior secondary. Our branch school had a farewell treat for all the students on the occasion of 15th Graduation day.

Graduation day:(March 31) The day has always been celebrated as an achievement day when an average of 150 children successfully completes their school education every year. This year, 72 boys and 62 girls graduated with the results awaited to pursue their higher education. I was so glad having a copy of the books published by the graduating children with "A Moments Pause for gratitude" as their book title. It was a compilation of different feelings expressed their articles by the outgoing students. We would like to thank Norzang Foundation for their grant support by taking up 75 children every year so that we can continue providing the scholarship to our children.

Inter-house activities: Several inter-house activities including essay writing, calligraphy, elocution, basket ball and football held during the two months.





Welcoming gifts: Special welcoming gifts were waiting for our children when they entered the school campus and their classes.
