2019 Project: Mussoorie and Rajpur

Mary Stevenson and Bev Judson spent two weeks in August 2019 in India at Tibetan Homes Foundation Schools, Rajpur and Mussoorie.



The focus was on a strategic approach to exam preparation. A key element of this was the use of a spreadsheet to analyse exam/test results and identify where teaching needs to be changed/targeted.

This led to the process of action planning to enable desired changes to be implemented. Running throughout this was an emphasis upon using strategies for Assessment for Learning in the classroom.

Both the headteacher at Mussoorie and the Principal at Rajpur voiced their intention for

teachers to use the spreadsheet across all subjects in school. They planned to arrange for key teachers who had attended the workshops to train other colleagues and in fact Bev and Mary were delighted to find this actually, already taking place towards the end of the Project.

The headteacher at Mussoorie attended all the workshops. He was very interested in the approach to action planning which was introduced and intends to use this more widely in the school. He also talked about ways of using the spreadsheet analysis and action planning to monitor the performance of underachieving students, across several departments.

Tibetan Children's Villages Pilot Project

As a result of further discussion which took place between the Director of TCV and Liz MacGarvey during her most recent visit, we can confirm that Pat Cameron and Liz MacGarvey will conduct a project at TVC Dharamsala between 6th and 17th of April 2020.

The programme will consist of two weeks of observations of Class 5 and Class 6 students. The focus will be on the effects of the introduction of English in different age groups. Students need to be proficient in English as all lessons and examinations across the curriculum in secondary years are conducted through the medium of English. The Team will explore possible ways forward for Hope One World to enhance provision in future years.
